Tehillim/Psalm 51:1-6

Redemption:

Speedily redeem Your Nation Yisrael, for You are a powerful Redeemer. Praised be Your Name, Redeemer of Yisrael.

Prayers for Purification

Items needed: small bowl of water and a bunch of hyssop (or parsley)

Take a moment to reflect on all your sins – sins in thought and sins in action

Dip the hyssop (parsley) in the water, and sprinkle it on yourself.

Prayer of Purification
